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Commemorative

As a musician, I have noticed that music - existing in time for an instant - expresses life's ephemeral nature and yet at the same time much music projects the constant renewing of the human spirit - just listen to Haydn or Bach! Music can refresh, celebrate and comfort.

Memorials and commemorative objects are traditionally permanent markers of a life or event. But to express the personality of the person to be remembered and to catch the right tone is harder. Each live performance of music is a unique piece of art, never to be exactly replicated again. The programmes of music for our concerts are chosen for being life-affirming, unusual, unique and intimate.

We invite you to dedicate one of our monthly concerts to someone special - it could be for someone deceased, a birthday or any celebration.

This would be as an inclusion on the inside page at the front of the printed programme and a small paragraph about the person. You can invite the people you want to attend and we will sell the remainder of the seats to the public.

About our music

We are about celebrating the joy of the human spirit and choose **mainly** programmes of delightful early and baroque music. But we don't rule out anything with enough notice! There will always be gentler pieces in our programmes for a moment's reflection. One month will be with a consort group of singers who might

sing some beautiful renaissance polyphony by Lassus, Lobo and Palestrina, and the next month could be a gamba, harpsichord and violin recital of french baroque pieces or a small orchestral concert.

Venues

We choose smaller intimate venues for this sort of music - rarely exceeding 200 seats. We perform in Oxfordshire, Bedfordshire, Northamptonshire, Warwickshire, Buckinghamshire. If, however, you contact us far enough in advance, we can arrange a concert further afield.
